

Training Opportunities for Registered Training Organisations

Did you know that additional training opportunities may be available to you by partnering with industry enterprises?

Would you like to gain more training opportunities while assisting the industry to upskill its workforce?

As part of its *Skills Connect* initiative, the Federal Government is providing funding through the National Workforce Development Fund to assist enterprises with their workforce development.

Under the Fund, enterprises must partner with RTOs when applying for funding to support the training of new and existing workers in areas of identified skills shortage. RTOs are encouraged to work with industry to submit proposals that address current and future business and workforce development needs.

The Transport and Logistics Industry Skills Council (TLISC) is managing the application process, and will provide you with assistance and guidance to access funding.

What support is available?

Size of Workforce (Full Time Equivalent)	Government Contribution (%)	Participating Organisation Contribution (%)
1 – 99 (small)	67	33
100 – 199 (medium)	50	50
200 + (large)	34	66

- ▶ For **existing workers** qualifications covered under the fund include Certificate III, IV, Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Vocational Graduate Certificate and Vocational Graduate Diploma.
- ▶ For **new workers** qualifications covered under the fund include Certificate II, III, IV, Diploma, Advanced Diploma, Vocational Graduate Certificate and Vocational Graduate Diploma.
- ▶ Support can be tailored to meet **individual** business needs. Enterprises must formally engage an RTO to deliver the training, so start a conversation with your industry partners now.
