

# Aviation Training Package

## Continuous Improvement Plan 2015



The Training Package development and endorsement process requires Training Packages to undergo a continuous improvement process to ensure the existing and emerging skill needs of industry are met.

The currently endorsed version of the Aviation Training Package is AVI08 Version 5.0 and AVI Release 2.0.

This Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) provides an outline of the changes planned for the endorsed components of the Aviation Training Package over 2014 – 2015. Information on items that have already been completed is available in the Aviation Training Package Continuous Improvement Plan – Completed Items Summary.

Information is drawn from a variety of intelligence sources, including: the Environmental Scan, Have Your Say Register, and ongoing consultation and engagement with industry stakeholders. The CIP is also impacted by national policy directives in relation to Training Package design, development and endorsement.

Quarterly updates are made to the CIP in February, May, August and November, and released on the website [tlisc.org.au](http://tlisc.org.au). Interim updates may also be released if significant developments occur.
