Terms of Reference



The Transport & Logistics Industry Skills Council (TLISC) is committed to the development of high quality training products and services to support excellence in training and assessment outcomes across the industry.

To support this action an RTO Advisory Committee has been established for RTO's who are actively engaged in the sectors of the Transport & Logistics industry for which TLISC is responsible: Aviation, Maritime, Rail, Logistics, Warehousing, Ports, and Road Transport.

The role of the Committee is to provide input and advice regarding issues which may impact on Training Package implementation. From this advice, training arrangements within the Vocational Education and Training (VET) system may be reviewed. VET in Australia focuses on Training Packages and the advice provided by Committee members is critical to ensuring Training Packages meet the needs of industry.

RTO Advisory Committee membership is open to representatives from private, public and enterprise Training Organisations. Participation is limited to one representative per RTO. Members will be selected based on skills and experience, and the group will aim to represent a balance of interests across the Transport and Logistics sectors.

Terms of Reference

The RTO Advisory Committee is responsible for provision of advice regarding:

- ▶ input and advice on Training Package implementation
- ▶ feedback on resources to support Training Package implementation
- ▶ intelligence on issues and opportunities to improve quality of training outcomes

Structure and Governance

- ▶ The RTO Advisory Committee will meet at least twice annually, or more frequently if required
- ▶ The RTO Advisory Committee Chair will be appointed by the TLISC Chief Executive Officer, or their nominee, on behalf of TLISC
- ▶ Meeting agendas and minutes will be prepared and distributed by TLISC which will provide the committee secretariat
- ▶ The deliberations and outcomes of qualifications review and development by steering committees will be reported to the RTO Advisory Committee for information only.
